Through the traditional Medicaid program, these two instruments may be billed as assessments based on their defined use. The CASII (formerly the CALOCUS) is an assessment and placement instrument. The CASII may be utilized to assess level of care needs for a child or adolescent client. It is designed to facilitate communication between clinical professionals and resource availability. The CASII creates a standard context in which all participants are working together (American Academy of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry). I hope this address your inquiry.
