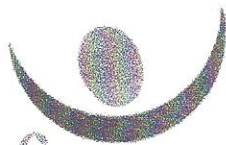

On March 24th 10am to 12pm, Randy Arnold LPAT, conducted a training on "The 5 languages of Appreciation". As an experiential (learn by experiencing) approach was used in the training, We had participants take a MBA (Motivating By Appreciation) Inventory in advance of the training. This valid inventory helps identify your "most valued languages" of appreciation, and your own "least valued languages of appreciation". It is a SHORT on-line inventory. While this is not an assessment you have to do for client's, the skills learned can easily be applied to connecting with families and children. Before the training, the trainer compiled the information from all of your inventories and presented it to the group finding as aggregate (confidential and general) data. Each participant will receive a copy of the results of your personal MBA Inventory. Identifying and learning these languages will help supervisors better connect with support staff, TCM's, and clients.
