

CONTRACT TO FURNISH PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

THIS CONTRACT made this 11th day of April, 2017,
between Transformations Hope for today's families, L.L.C., of 1729A Highway 44 East,
Shepherdsville, KY 40165, herein referred to as Company, and
Amanda Alexander, of 7806 Lariat Rd,
Louisville, ky, 40219, herein referred to as
Contractor.

RECITALS

- A. Company is in the business of mental health and family services, and in the conduct of such business, Company desires to have Contractor provide counseling and therapy services to clients.
- B. The parties stipulate that Contractor is a professional person, and that the relation created by this contract is that of employer-independent contractor. Contractor is not an employee of the employer, and Contractor shall have sole control of the manner and means of performing this contract, and shall complete all services hereunder according to his or here own methods and time tables.
- C. Contractor shall adhere to all laws, regulations, ethics and standards applicable to their profession and shall perform in a manner consistent with generally accepted procedures for that profession. The Company, or clients.

D. Contractor is not to be considered and agent or employee of Company for any purpose, and Contractor shall not hold themselves out as such. It is understood that Company does not agree to use contractor exclusively. It is further understood that Contractor is free to contract for similar services to be performed for other employers or entities while under contract with owner.

E. Contractor agrees to perform these services for Company under the terms and conditions set forth in this contract; and to provide any and all necessary records and documentation requested.

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this contract, it is agreed by and between Company and Contractor:

SECTION ONE

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The work to be performed by contractor includes all services generally performed by Contractor in Contractor's usual line of business, including but not limited to,
Marketing and Community Relations.

SECTION TWO

PAYMENT

Company will pay Contractor the total sum of 20⁰⁰, for the work performed under this contract. Said payment will be only after receipt of payment from the client, or payor on behalf of client.

SECTION THREE

LIABILITY

The work performed under this contract will be performed entirely at the Contractor's risk, and Contractor assumes all responsibility in the performance of this contract. Contractor will carry, for the duration of this contract, professional liability insurance in an amount acceptable to Company.

SECTION FOUR

INDEMNIFICATION

Contractor shall indemnify employer against all liability or loss, and against all claims or actions based on or arising out of damage or injury (including death) to persons or property caused by or sustained in connection with the performance or the contract or conditions created thereby, or based on any violation of any statute, laws, regulations, ethics, or standards applicable to their profession, and the defense of any such claim or actions. Contractor shall also indemnify the employer against all liability and loss in connection with, and shall assume full responsibility for, payment of all federal, state, and local taxes or contributions imposed or required under unemployment insurance, social security and income tax laws.

SECTION FIVE

ANTI-ASSIGNMENT CLAUSE

Neither this agreement or any interest herein, or claim hereunder, shall be assigned or transferred by Contractor to any party or parties.

SECTION SIX

DURATION

This agreement shall be in force for a period of one year from the date or execution.

In the event that either party does not desire to renew this contract at the expiration of its term, notice in writing must be given at least thirty (30) days before its expiration by such party to the other party informing such other party that the contract is not to be renewed; otherwise it shall be construed that the contract shall be automatically renewed for another year.

SECTION SEVEN

TERMINATION

This agreement may be terminated at anytime by mutual agreement of Company and Contractor, or by either party with ten (10) days written notice to the other party.

SECTION EIGHT

GOVERNING LAW


This contract shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
